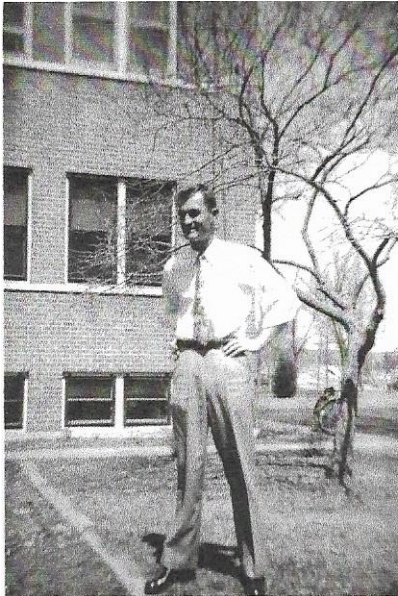

A FUN AFTERNOON!?

On a lovely spring day in April of 1950 seven high school girls got spring fever and wanted to do something fun. We decided to skip classes and take a walk by the railroad tracks. It was a lovely afternoon, and we did consider the consequences, but we had a young, good looking male teacher whom we all had a school girl crush on and we knew he would keep us out of trouble when we got back. Well, we misjudged him! Our punishment was to stay for an hour after school every day for the rest of the school year, or so it seemed. I don't know if we left any footprints, but we all learned a lesson!

Connie Edelman Elliott Class of 1961 I had older siblings that left Footprints for me to follow, one brother very studious, one brother very full of tricks. I guess I tried to follow both, as was too scared to

do anything 'wrong' in my earlier years. Trading cars so we could ride with our boyfriends when returning from a ballgame thinking the Supt. wouldn't find out. His car stopped to eat and ours didn't. Losing our music letters our senior year...I was following Gary Sherman's Footprints, ...when we ignored our music teacher at the State Music Conference. Trading instruments for our Annual pictures wasn't a Footprint we needed to leave. Had we known that others would be following our Footprints, we may have made other choices, making some straighter and on different paths. It is fun to see the Footprints left by the Alumni of TCHS.

I had a lot of good teachers. Joyce Carr was one of my very favorite and I would not have been able to continue to teach our deaf son, Terry, had she not been the excellent teacher she was. I remain in contact with her and greatly admire her strength and wisdom.

Gene Weber, Class of 1961, My footprint in the sand was in the hall ways of TCHS. I'm pretty sure neither shifting sand or dust of my presence out last the first good wind after May 8th 1961. Special memories include Classmates, good coaches, Supt John Carr and Staff. I recall riding to school with the Johnston Brothers, & the Clark boys. Boarding in town with the Mercer family, Elliotts, Good times there. Sometimes because of Ronnie and sometimes despite Ronnie. Other than the Trojan yearbook the only other evidence of my four years at Thedford would be an entry-shared with friend and roommate Howard Wright- at the Thomas County Court house. For the last 50 years I have been living my version of the "Good Life" in Greeley Colorado.

Beth Baxter, Class of 1971, My "footprint in the sand at THS" was probably my competitive spirit to represent THS the very best that I could in whatever I did. Many times over the years when involved in an "ice breaker" exercise (you know that one where they want the person to tell them something they would never guess about them) I usually tell them that during the very first Nebraska Girls High School Track Meet I was one of a team of 5 girls who won the Class D Championship and still hold the Class D record in the girls 100 yard dash (because they don't run it anymore ☺).

Kent Magnuson, Class of 1971 I'm not sure I left any "footprints" at THS, but I do know that my experiences and friends at THS influenced the rest of my life, most of all, hooking back up with Beth. I'm looking forward to seeing you all again.

Mark Barnes, Class of 1981 Footprints that I left at Thedford High School are in the dirt of the tunnel under the school that a few of us guys became familiar with. There was a crawl space that ran under part of the school and some of us boys used to see how fast we could get from under the stage and come out between the science and history rooms.

The greatest impact on me was the time spent with Mr. Linn. Because of his influence on me, I am still doing work related to what he taught me as the Payroll/HR Manager for a group of orthopedic surgeons. Greatest teacher of all time!
