A delicious dinner, catered by The Double T in Halsey and owned by Reta Teahon, was served. The menu consisted of baked steak, baked potatoes, green beans, salad, rolls and cupcakes.

Two banners with the Alumni Banquet date are on display entering town from the east and west.
